

New Critical Care Unit - 11th Floor Charing Cross Hospital

Project Description

- Following a successful tender Cuffe plc were initially awarded the fit out contract for the new state of the art Critical Care Unit at Charing Cross Hospital.
- Once this initial contract had been successfully completed Cuffe plc negotiated two further major contracts, initially 11 East Offices and thereafter 11 West HDU.
- Works to all contracts were completed to the highest standards under the direction of the design team and medical consultants.
- The use of limestone flooring and glass partitioning together with fitted furniture, IPS units and joinery of the highest standard ensured that the facility retained a striking appearance whilst not compromising clinical requirement.
- From a clinical perspective the CCU and HDU bed positions were served using ceiling mounted pendants. Cuffe plc were responsible for the co-ordination and installation of all medical equipment including the pendants, theatre lights and surgeons panels. The CCU also contained two isolation rooms.
- All works to the 11th floor were undertaken using an external hoist ensuring that all site deliveries could be made with the minimum of disruption to the hospital.
